Re: Galway City Council Resolution

Dear Minister O'Brien,

I wish to advise that at the February Meeting of Galway City Council held on Monday, 9 February 2026, the Members passed the following resolution:

NoM 07/2026, amended by Cllr. A. Curran on 09/02/2026

That in light of the increase in road traffic fatalities and incidents in 2025, representing a failure of national road safety leadership, that this council will write to the Minister for Transport calling for the following:

- That funding will be issued to Galway City Council to pilot the installation of red-light cameras at key junctions on publication of the National Safety Camera Strategy later this year, and that any fines collected would be retained by Galway City Council to help offset costs of other road safety improvements.
- That this council calls for a re-evaluation of the role of the RSA and that the recommendations of the Indecon Report 2024 should be implemented immediately.

Upon adoption, this motion is circulated to all Local Authorities.
