Introduction

This project will provide wider and safer cycle lanes on Belgard Road from the junction with Old Bessington Road to the junction with Cookstown Road. The cycle lanes will be segregated from motorists by a new raised concrete kerb. The existing narrow cycle lanes will be widened into the grass verge to a width of 2 meters and traffic lanes will be maintained at 3 metres each.

The project also proposes the following:

- Improvement to junctions along the route to provide safe crossings and connections for all road users.
- Safe crossing facilities for pedestrians and cyclists on all four arms of the roundabout at Belgard Road/Belgard Square North.

Commencement of Construction

- The construction of the Tallaght to Clondalkin Cycle Scheme Phase 1 as shown on the layout below has been awarded to Clonmel Enterprises.
- Construction is scheduled to Start at the beginning of August 2026 and will be completed in 10 months.
- Leaflets about the commencement of construction of the scheme will be delivered to all residents and businesses in the vicinity of the scheme before commencement of the works.
