COMMUNITY GRANTS FOR NOTING

(a.) Community Infrastructure Fund

The Community Infrastructure Fund of €450,000 provided in the Council's 2026 Revenue Budget again offered community groups, including sports clubs, the opportunity to apply for funding to assist with the costs of either constructing new facilities or for the modernisation and/or expansion of existing facilities. Groups, including boards of management of community facilities, could apply online for grants ranging from a minimum of €5,000 up to a maximum of €50,000 during the period from 12th March to 16th April 2026 to respond to locally identified needs within their communities. The fund was heavily oversubscribed, and a detailed assessment process based on the proposed projects' local community impact, value for money, funding, sustainability and viability took place. A total amount of €450,000 in funding for the following community infrastructure grants approved under the 2026 fund are as follows:
