Tap 2025-2029 September Update

Construction/Re-development

Oldcastle Park

The council continue to engage with residents regarding the redevelopment of this site. Four of the five families' clusters have engaged, and agreement has been reached on their future housing need within the future redevelopment of the site for three of the family clusters. Consultation is ongoing with the fourth family in relation to their housing need and location within the proposed redevelopment.

The TAU are engaging with architects and residents in scheduling the required onsite preplanning surveys and site screenings and assessments.

Housing Construction presented the final masterplan, including the Traveller accommodation to the March Clondalkin Area Committee meeting and are presenting the final version of the masterplan to the Clondalkin Area Committee meeting on 16th September in advance of the Part 8 consultation.

Tap 2025 – 2029 September Update

Kishogue Park

The new temporary halting site is now operational and families have settled in well. Homework Club fully connected and operational.

The de-commissioning of the old site by the contractor is complete and works on the permanent accommodation has commenced.

Lock Road Development

Part 8 Planning Application was advertised on 29th January 2026 for the redevelopment of Lock Road site consisting of 3 halting site bays with a day unit and adjacent mobile unit, 1 x 3 bed cottage, homework club, play area, and storage shed on lands adjacent to the current site. A total of 9 submissions were received for consideration, a report was presented and approved at the May council meeting. The project has proceeded to Tender and Design stage.

Tap 2025 – 2029 September Update

New Construction

Aderrig Glade, Adamstown, Co. Lucan

The handover of the six four-bedroom homes is due to take place in Q4 2026. Following a successful Choice Based Letting Scheme of Priority, offers have been made and accepted by six families.

On confirmation of the handover date, tenancy training and signups will take place.

Graydon Rise, Newcastle, Co Dublin

Six, home on Graydon Rise, Newcastle were advertised on Traveller Specific Choice Based Letting Scheme of Priority with the closing date 13th March 2026. Twenty-three Expressions of Interest applications were received, and following the evaluation process, the TAU issued five offers which were all accepted and the final 5-bedroom unit was offered to a family from the medical transfer list, which was accepted.

The allocation of the 6 properties was completed on the 4th August 2026
